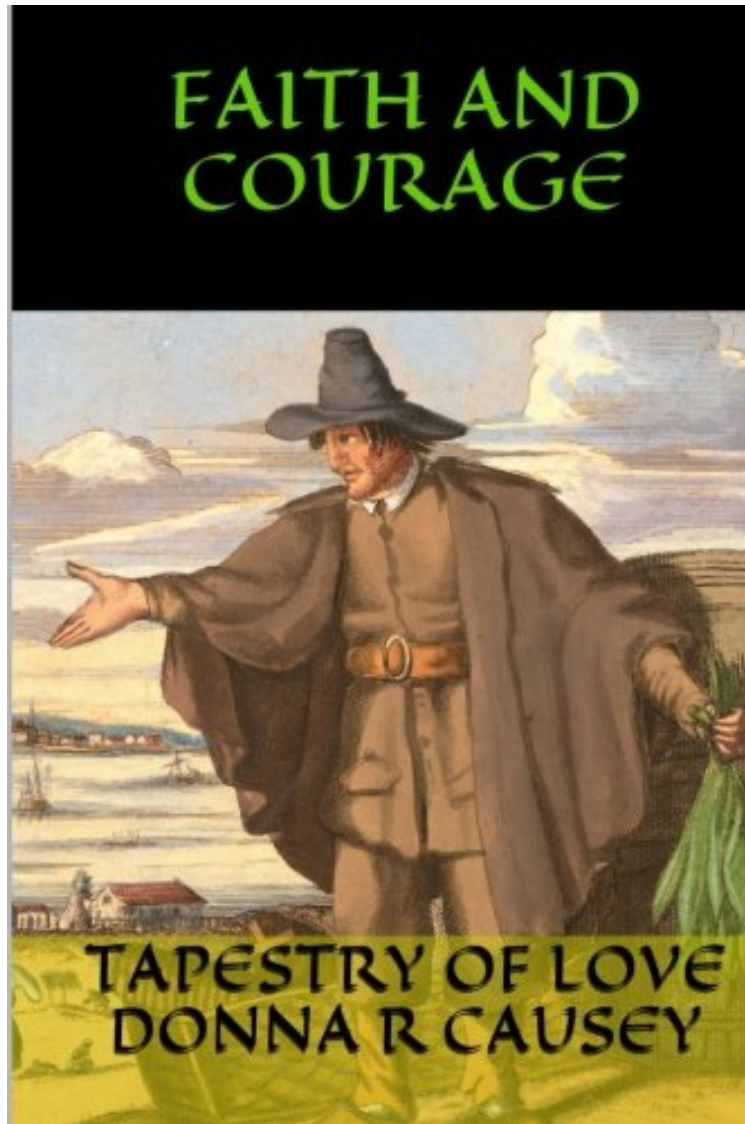

Faith and Courage presents the religious persecution of Quakers in Pre-Revolutionary War days of America intertwined with a love story.
