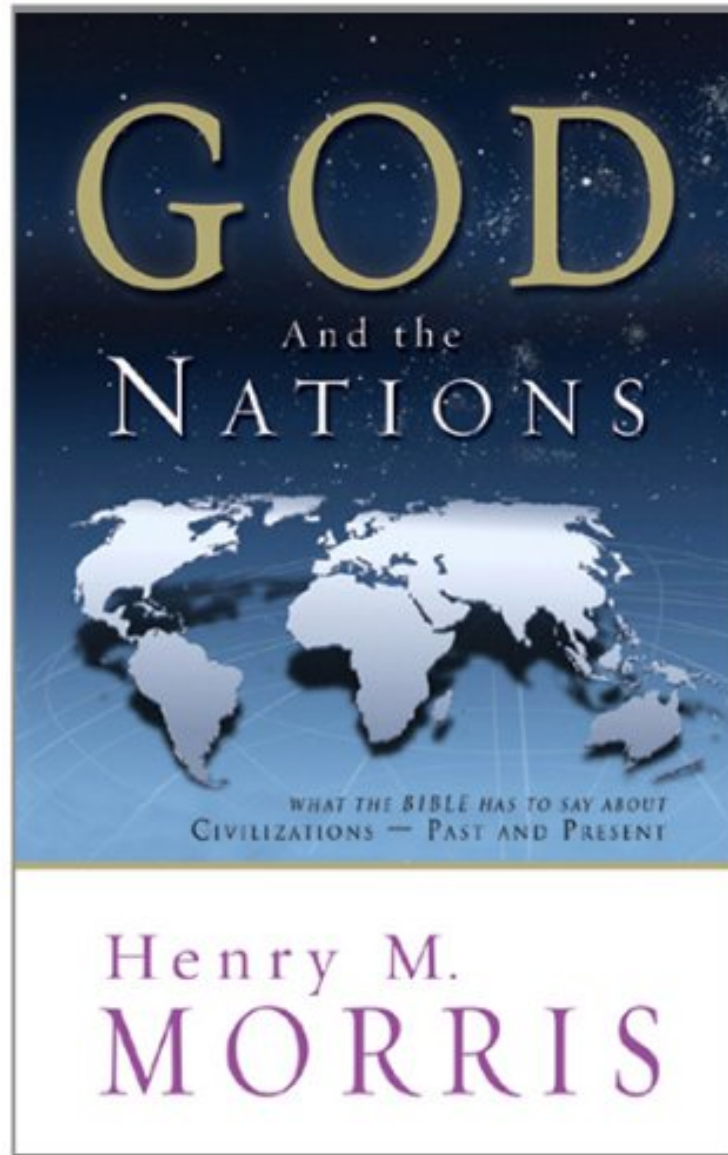

Indeed, of the 200 nations in existence today, only a handful actively seek God.
