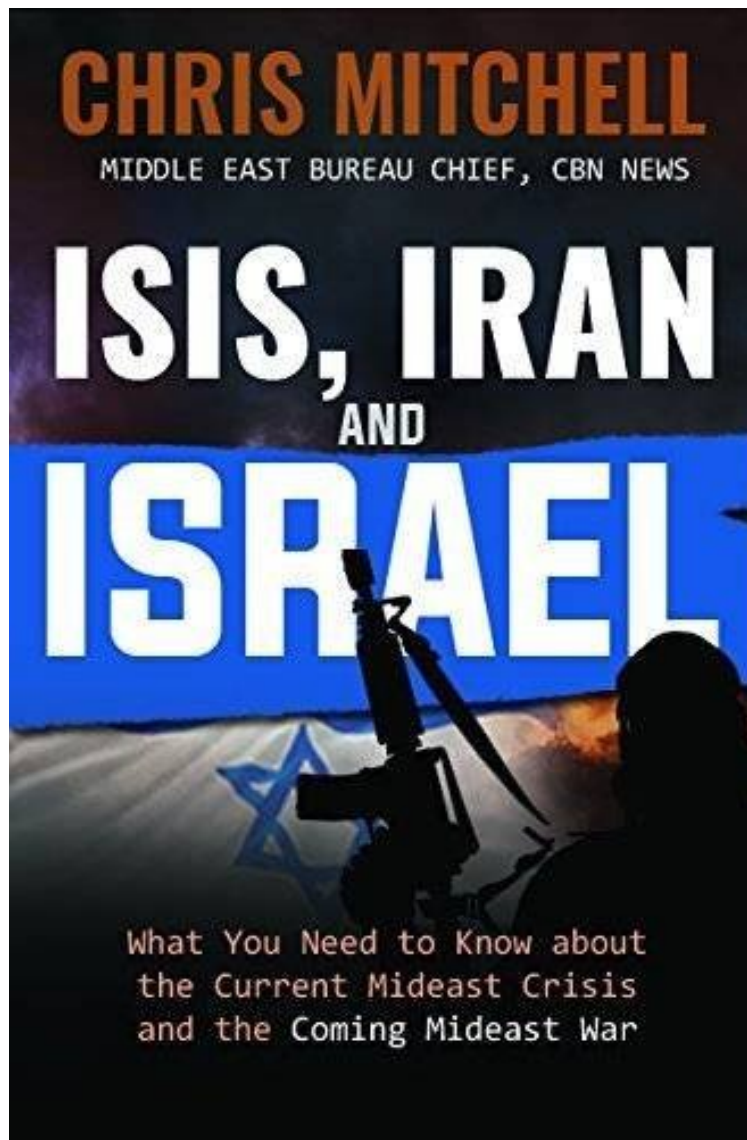

Many of us in the United States are ignorant or just vaguely aware of what is happening there, who the various parties are, and how it inevitably will touch our own lives. Chris Mitchell's book is an excellent introduction to all of those issues. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu warns Iran is developing nuclear weapons not just to annihilate Israel but to destroy the West. U.S. Senator Tom Cotton tells us the Iran deal will lay nuclear trip wires throughout the Middle East, while a German reporter writes ISIS is planning a nuclear tsunami to fulfill its apocalyptic version of Islam.
